In this project, reBOOT Canada is embarking on an initiative to engage youth in a paid internship program to learn useful computer repair and small business development skills, with a view to extending to the duration and reaching out to more remote communities in the coming months.

The terms are straightforward: we're looking initially for youth living in the greater Toronto Area between 18 and 29 years old to work up to 28 hours in a paid placement throughout the coming months (26 weeks).

Requirements

As this position is based on a grant, candidates' must:

- Identify as from a First Nation, Métis or Inuit background
- Be registered with Miziwe Biik Aboriginal Employment and Training
- Must be a resident of the GTA
