Miziwe Biik Aboriginal Employment and Training is excited to announce the new upcoming, Indigenous Skills and Employment Training (ISET) Program starting April 03, 2019.

Presently, the Terms and Conditions along with budgets of ISET are being developed by the Government of Canada, Employment and Social Development Canada (ESDC).

In anticipation of a new ISET agreement Miziwe Biik is preparing for the Urban Labour Market Program by issuing the first round of a Call for Proposals (to be rolled out at the information session November 29, 2019), closing January 15, 2019 at 12 PM (noon).

The Board of Directors is encouraging, but not limited to, training projects that address emerging employment trends such as: Technology based training, Management training, Project Management training, Economic development, Cultural programs and Summer student job opportunities.
