The Victim Rights Advocate Trainee will assist clients to know, understand and achieve their legal rights through advocacy and education. This includes, client intake; meeting with clients; gathering information; maintaining files; identifying community supports; performing outreach activities; preparing community legal educational materials and presenting education to client groups and other helping agencies.
